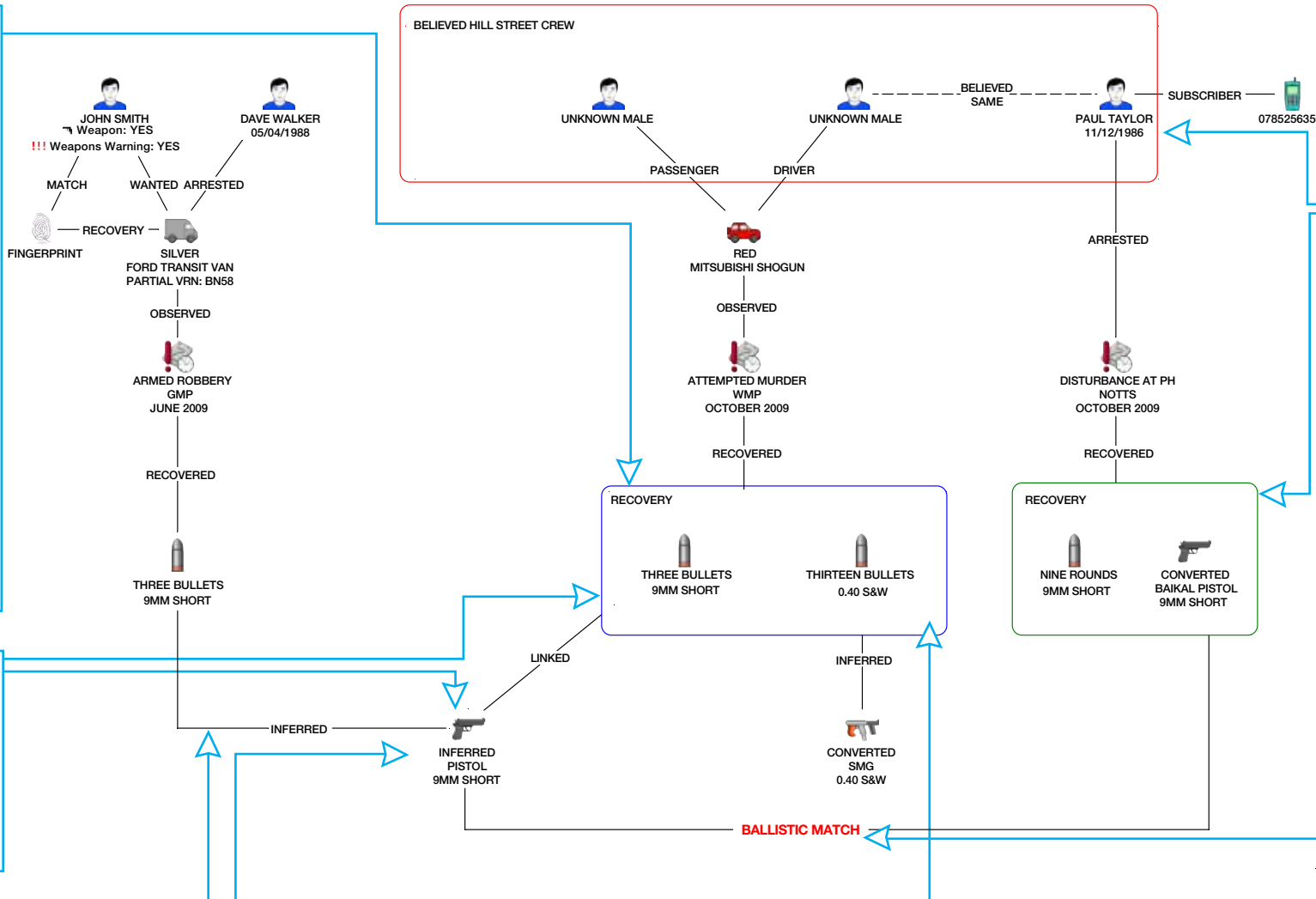


The picture below is a mock illustration of the information provided to a police force.

1. In this box marked 'Recovery' is the ballistic material that has been sent to a NABIS hub. In this instance the material is two different types of bullets. This material was recovered by West Midlands Police from the scene of an attempted murder in October 2009. A red Shogun car was seen at the scene along with two unknown men.

Note: So far we have ballistic material that is linked to an attempted murder and intelligence that also links a red Shogun and two men.

2. The three bullets have also been linked to an inferred pistol, which is a weapon that has been identified from ballistic material but has yet to be recovered.



3. Ballistic material recovered in June 2009 by Greater Manchester Police from an armed robbery where a silver Ford Transit van was used, is also linked to the inferred pistol. One man has been arrested for this offence and one man is still wanted but has been identified

Note: The intelligence shows that the ballistic material recovered by West Midlands Police could have come from the inferred weapon used at the scene of the armed robbery in Greater Manchester.

4. The thirteen bullets recovered from the attempted murder scene by West Midlands Police have been linked to an inferred, converted 'sub-machine gun (SMG). If this firearm is used again and ballistic material is recovered and sent to NABIS, the team will be able to link any incidents to the weapon as well as any cars or people involved in those incidents.

5. The inferred pistol linked to the three bullets recovered by West Midlands Police, has been found to be a ballistic match to a converted Biakal pistol recovered in Nottingham in October 2009 following a disturbance at a public house. A man has been arrested and is believed to be one of the men seen at the scene of the attempted murder in the West Midlands.

Note: From the ballistic material recovered at the scene of the attempted murder by West Midlands Police, a link has been made to an inferred pistol used in a robbery in Manchester. A ballistic match has then been made to a Biakal pistol used in Nottingham where ballistic material was also recovered. This has also linked the offender arrested for the disturbance in Nottingham to the attempted murder in West Midlands. In addition the ballistic material recovered from the attempted murder in West Midlands links the same weapon to the a robbery in Manchester.
